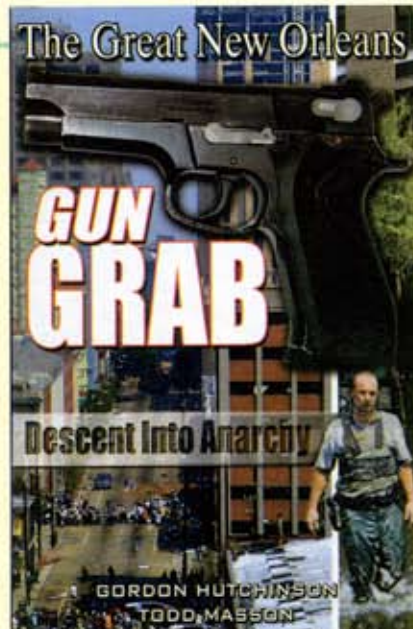

The Great New Orleans Gun Grab: Descent Into Anarchy

This is one of the most disturbing books I've ever read. It is the story of the injustice imposed on law-abiding New Orleans residents by prowling bands of thugs and then their own government in the aftermath of the Hurricane Katrina disaster. In it, authors Gordon Hutchinson and Todd Masson detail individual tales of gunowners defending their homes and families in lawless days after the hurricane struck and their brutal treatment afterwards by police—those supposed to protect them—after NOPD Police Superintendent Eddie Compass ordered: "No one will be able to be armed. Guns will be taken. Only law enforcement will be allowed to have guns." You will read the chilling tales of everyday people

like LeRoy Hartley, who stood his ground against looters and then the NOPD and BATF, of Patricia Konie who had police kick in her door and slam her to the floor for merely holding a century-old pistol inside her own home. The authors also chronicle the "Second Battle of New Orleans," the legal fight led by NRA to have firearms unlawfully confiscated by police returned to their rightful owners and the drive to protect the rights of law-abiding gun owners in the wake of disaster. It is a story of abuse of government power, and after reading it; you too will say "Never Again and "Remember New Orleans." *The Great New Orleans Gun Grab* is a must read for those concerned about our civil rights as American firearm owners.
